How To Install Your eBook

Thank you for purchasing! Below are instructions on how to install our eBooks on the most popular electronic readers currently on the market. Please search for the device you own and follow the instructions. For all devices, the eBook must be downloaded to your computer first. Then connect the device to your computer to transfer the eBook to your reader.

How to install your eBook on an Amazon Kindle (Mobi file)

- Connect your Kindle to your computer via a USB cable. After drivers are installed, you can see your Kindle
 device as a disk drive. (On a Windows-based computer, this will show up by clicking the "My Computer"
 icon. On a Mac-based computer, this will show up as an icon on the desktop.)
- 2. Navigate to the "documents" folder on your Kindle device.
- 3. Copy your downloaded eBook from its current location on your computer to this "documents" folder on your Kindle device.
- 4. Safely eject the device. (On a Windows-based computer, click on the "Safely Remove Hardware" icon on the bottom-right of the toolbar. On a Mac-based computer, drag the Kindle icon to the trash can.)

How to install your eBook on a Barnes & Noble Nook (ePub file)

- 1. Connect your Nook to your computer via a USB cable. After drivers are installed, you can see your Nook device as a disk drive. (On a Windows-based computer, this will show up by clicking the "My Computer" icon. On a Mac-based computer, this will show up as an icon on the desktop.)
- 2. Navigate to the "My Documents" folder on your Nook device.
- 3. Copy your downloaded eBook from its current location on your computer to this "My Documents" folder on your Nook device.
- 4. Safely eject the device. (On a Windows-based computer, click on the "Safely Remove Hardware" icon on the bottom-right of the toolbar. On a Mac-based computer, drag the Nook icon to the trash can.)
- 5. After disconnnecting the device, you can view the eBook by clicking "My Library/My Documents."

How to install your eBook on an Apple iPad, iPhone or iPod (ePub file)

1. Add the eBook file to your iTunes Library on your computer.

There are two ways to do this:

- a. Go to the "File" menu, select "Add To Library" and navigate to where the eBook file is located on your computer.
- b. You can also drag the file to the top-left portion of the iTunes window where it lists your Library options.
- 2. Connect your iPad, iPhone or iPod to your computer via the provided Apple cable that came with your device. If your device is already set to sync Books from your iTunes library, your eBook will be available to view using the iBooks app on your iPhone, iPad or iPod once the sync completes.

To change your Book syncing options, please do the following:

- a. Click on your specific device when it shows up in the left column under "Devices."
- b. Click on the "Books" tab towards the top-right of the iTunes window.
- c. Click on the checkbox next to "Sync Books," so that a checkmark appears in the box. This will default to sync all eBooks in your iBooks library every time you connect your device to your computer. You can, however, change the option to "Selected books" and manually pick which eBooks you want to sync onto your iPad, iPhone or iPod.
- d. Click the "Apply" button at the bottom-right of the iTunes window to apply the new settings and begin syncing the device.

How to add an ebook to a Kobo ereader (ePub file)

To add ePUB books to your eReader using a Windows computer

- Connect your eReader to your computer using the USB cable. Your eReader will prompt you to either keep reading or manage your library. You can use your computer or the Desktop Application to add books and manage your eReader.
- Using the Navigation Pad, select "Manage Library". Windows should detect that you connected a new device.
- 3. When prompted for an action, select 'Open folder to view files.' A window should open, showing the contents of your eReader.
- 4. In another Explorer window, navigate to where you stored the eBooks you want to move to your eReader.
- 5. Drag and drop your eBooks into the eReader window. You can now disconnect your eReader and read your new books.

To add ePUB books to your eReader using a Mac computer

- 1. Connect your eReader to your computer using the USB cable. Your eReader will prompt you to either keep reading or manage your library. You can use your computer or the Desktop Application to add books and manage your eReader.
- 2. Using the Navigation Pad, select "Manage Library".
- 3. On your computer, open your Finder application.
- 4. Select KOBO eReader from your list of devices. Finder should display the contents of your eReader.
- 5. In another Finder window, navigate to where you stored the eBooks you want to transfer to your eReader.
- 6. Drag and drop your eBooks into the eReader window. You can now disconnect your eReader and read your new books.

Turn on your eReader and find your new ebooks. They will be in the "ebooks" area if the files were ePUBs, or in the "documents" area if they were PDFs.
